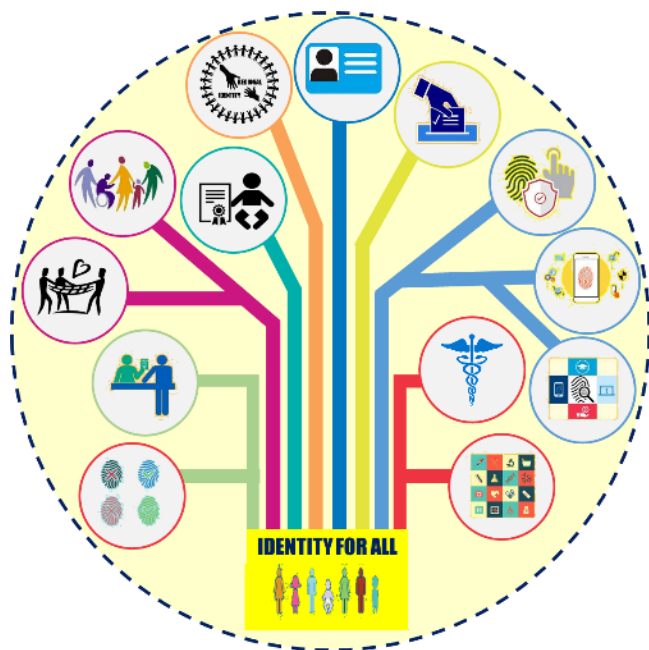
THE ANNUAL MEETING REPORT

The Meeting was significant in many ways. The exchange was substantive, the gathering was truly pan-African and inclusive and the intensity was at a an all time high.

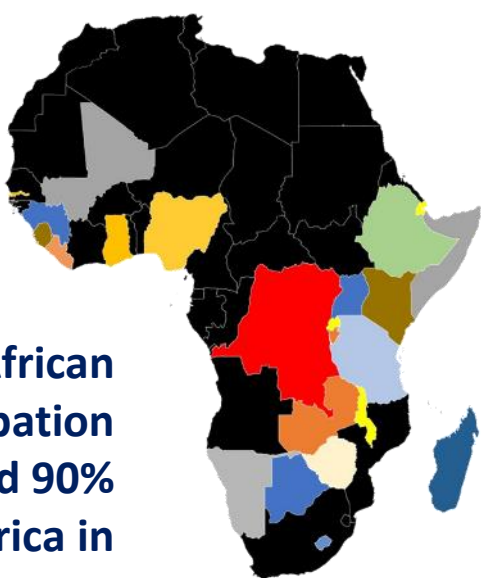

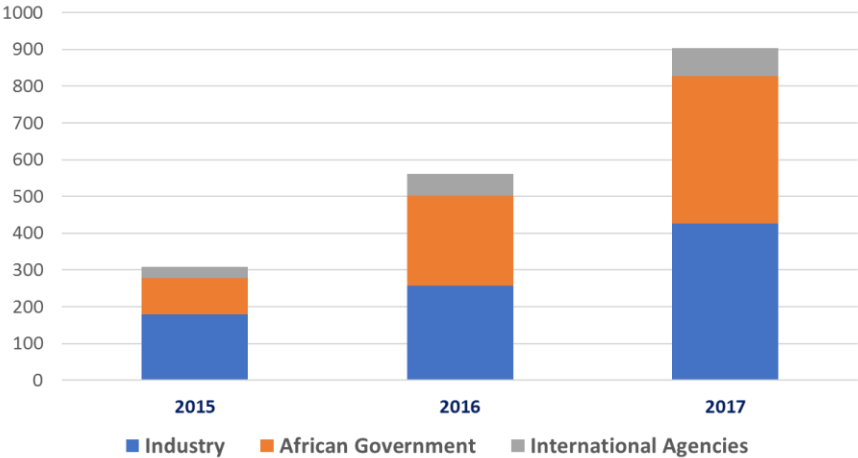

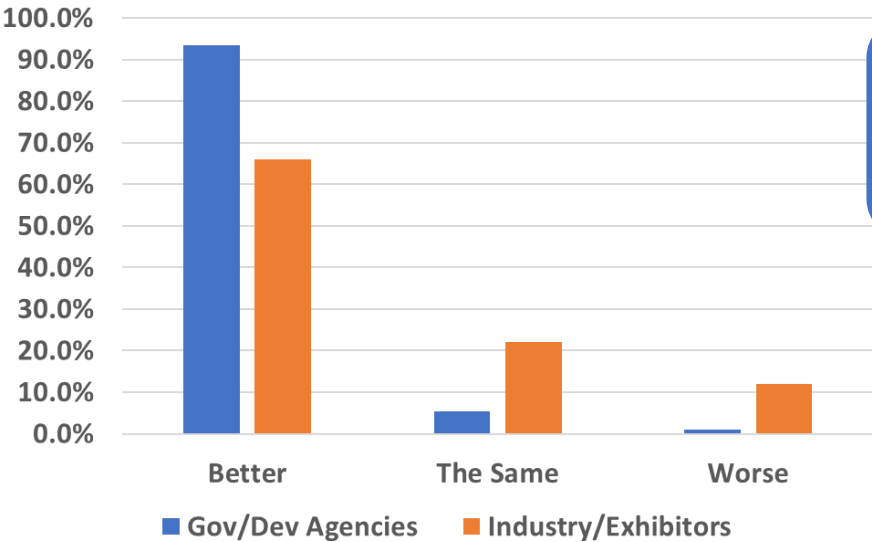

thought that ID4Africa 2017 was better than 2016, even though 2016 was a milestone event that many had said was hard to beat.

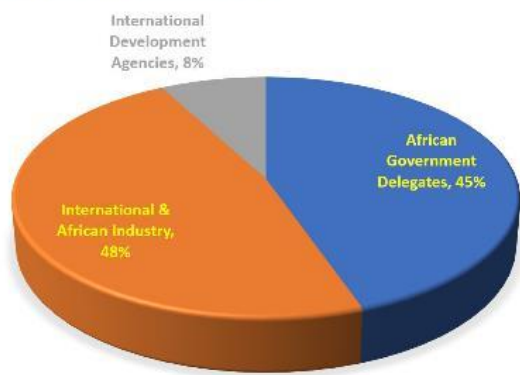

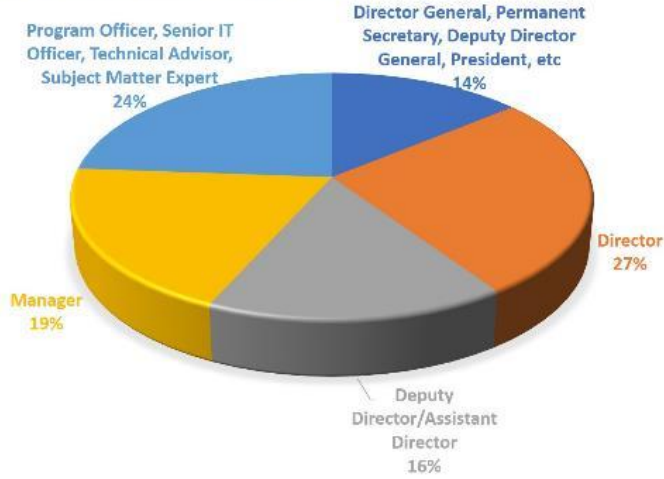


ATTENDEE COMPOSITION

DELEGATES BY STAKEHOLDER TYPE



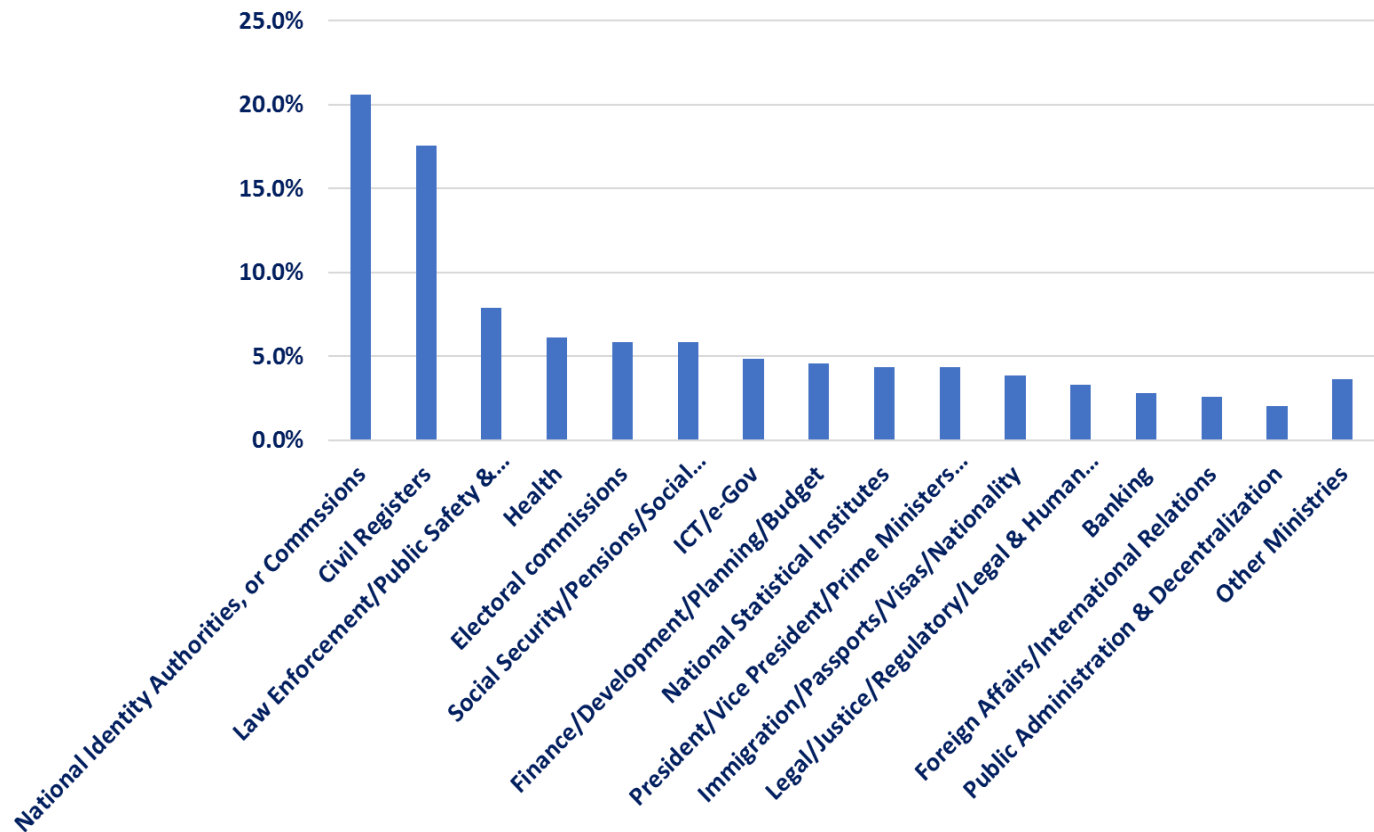
GOVERNMENT DELEGATES BY JOB TITLE



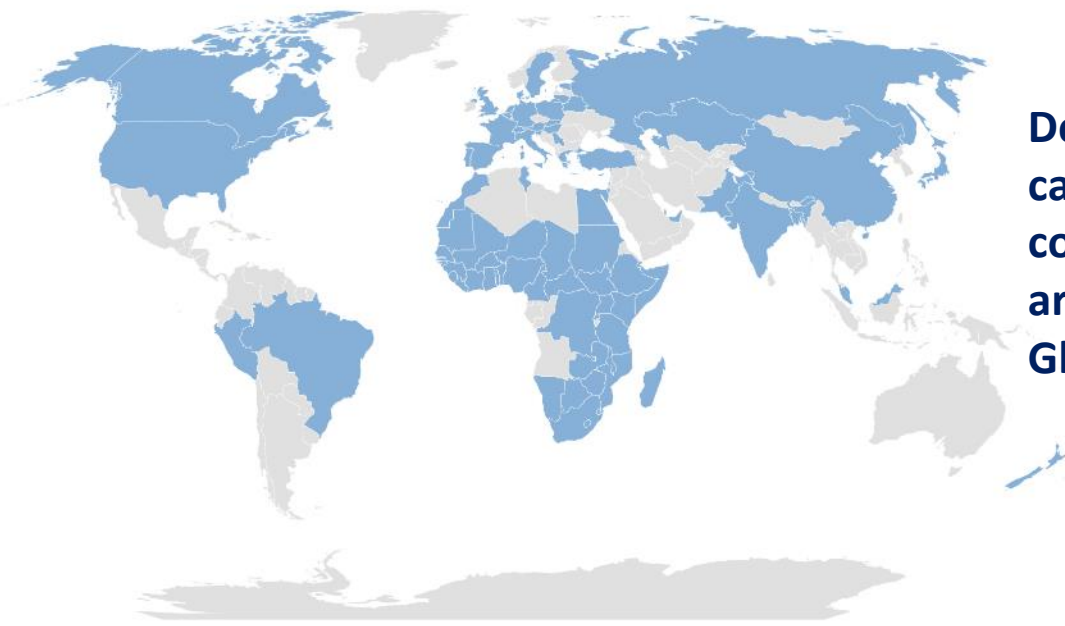
African Government Representation was not only very strong in numbers but it also consisted of senior decision makers.

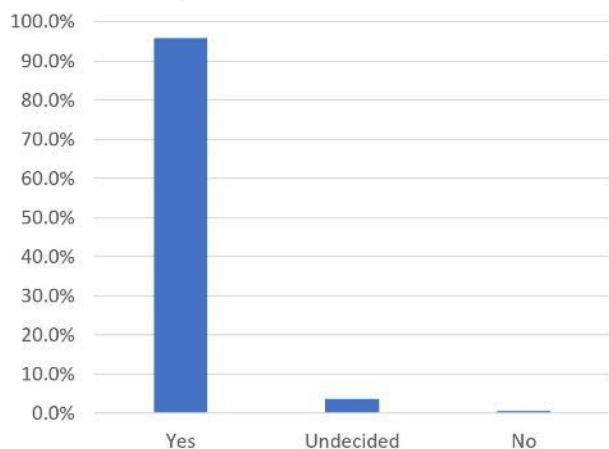

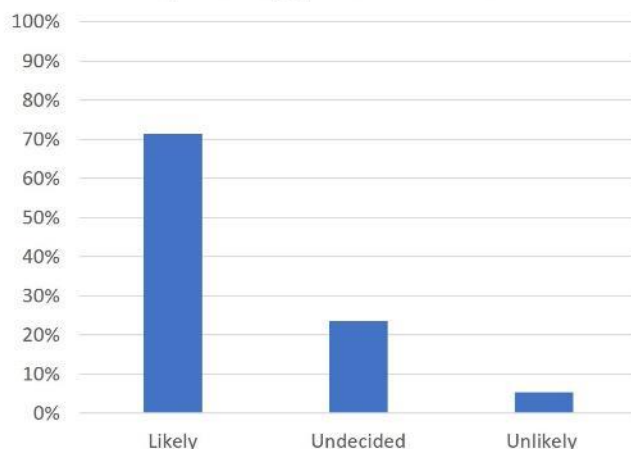
