

Recognizes that there is no unique way for achieving *identity for all* but that there are many pathways depending on what assets a country has and what priorities dictate action.


The Meeting was significant in many ways. The exchange was substantive, the gathering was truly pan-African and inclusive and the intensity was at a an all time high.










